Frequently Asked Questions

How will the changes to the Pfizer MEG model for 2012 affect the grants in thrombosis/anti-coagulation?

Grant requests related to thrombosis prevention or anti-coagulation should still be submitted to Bristol-Myers Squibb. The changes to the Pfizer MEG model for 2012 do not affect or apply to these grants.

Pfizer has an Alliance agreement with Bristol-Myers Squibb for medical education grant support. Do these changes to the Pfizer grants model also apply to BMS?
