



The Joint Commission and Pfizer Medical Education Group Antimicrobial Stewardship: Letter of Intent (LOI) Review Meeting

Objective: The Expert Review Panel (ERP) convened to discuss and determine which LOI's would be invited to submit full proposals.

Number of LOIs submitted for review: 133

Number of LOIs invited to submit full proposals: 12

Review Process:

The LOI review process was divided into two stages. In Stage 1 the ERP members were divided into three two-person teams. Each team reviewed one third of the LOIs with the aim of identifying those to forward to the next evaluation stage. In Stage 2 the entire review panel evaluated the 24 LOIs forwarded by the two-person teams. Of the 24 reviewed by the entire panel 12 were selected to submit full proposals.
